



Student re-development site with planning granted for a 348 bed scheme including cluster flats and studios.

Description

An ideally situated site just a stones throw from Strathclyde University's campus. The old Martyrs Church site is now cleared and has planning granted for a 348 bed student scheme, comprising of 173 studios/ 176 clusters (49% studios/ 51% clusters split). Planning application 15/01232/DC .

Previously the Martyrs Church had occupied the site, this was demolished in April 2015 in preparation for work to begin on the new student accommodation scheme.

Location:

Glasgow is the largest city in Scotland and the third largest in the UK. It is situated on the River Clyde in the country's West Central Lowlands. Glasgow is home to three universities; The University of Glasgow, Glasgow Caledonian University and the University of Strathclyde.
